Stewardship—Fr. Tripp Jeffords

Dearest Parish Family,

I hope this letter finds you well and blessed beyond all measure. Having served over twenty years in the priesthood, I know that when people hear the word "stewardship," they often shut down. Please don't! Let me have just a few moments of your time.

In II Corinthians, our patron saint the Apostle Paul, writes to his parish church encouraging them, saying that those who "sow sparingly will also reap sparingly, but those who sow generously will reap generously." Paul concludes with these words, "Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giv-

Here, at our present day church of St. Paul's, we know the value of sowing and reaping. During lean financial times in our history, we have been forced to cut back on the Lord's work. Sometimes we have had to decrease our ministry impact and at other times we have been forced to remove staff positions altogether. On the other hand, when we have sown generously, we have enjoyed a greater kingdom impact for Jesus. We have reaped generously. A fellow priest once said, "Like it or not, money is the muscle for ministry." The bottom Line: your church needs you in order to function well for Christ.

In II Corinthians, notice that Paul's stewardship appeal is not based on the law, nor coercion of any sort, nor under "compulsion." Paul, instead, appeals directly to the heart, because their donations were a form of heart-felt worship. Christians give thanks to God with tithes and offering for all that God has done for us. That's what we do. We also seek to invest in Gospel inspired ministry, because the Gospel has changed our lives. In the final analysis, stewardship is about loving God and loving neighbor. And when we do these acts of love due to generosity and grace, we find that God does, indeed, "love a cheerful giver."

In conclusion, I am encouraging you all to "sow generously," so that our ministries will "reap generously" for Jesus. Give what you and Jesus have "decide in your heart." Pray about a sacrificial commitment to the Lord's work here in 2019. Finally, don't let stewardship be a downer, for God loves a "cheerful giver."

Look for a stewardship packet in the mail later this week. Please read through it and pray about making a "generous" and heartfelt commitment.
